

Every pilot must analyse and observe airspaces on their flight route.

There used to be a simple basis for flying under visual flight rules: The expectation was that one could navigate by terrestrial features. And indeed, in older ICAO charts there are many airspace boundaries that are based on easily recognisable ground features.

rules) pilots cannot avoid checking NOTAMs (notice to air missions) before each flight, viewing the flight route on a chart and constantly updating the electronic navigation aids.

Many changes take place over the course of a year, which are introduced monthly at the aeronautical information regulation and control appointment. Changes to the ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation) chart are documented in the AIP VFR GEN 0-33 ff. Supplements contain construction measures and other special features. In the complex airspaces of today, this is no longer possible. However, the principle of visual aviation still applies: Above all, looking outside (and not at the display)!

Appeal: Make an impact

Airspace planning is based on the interests of IFR (instrument flight rules) aviation and the requirements of air traffic controllers. As a result, the concerns and needs of VFR (visual flight rules) customers are not always taken into account.

However, DFS (German Air Traffic Control) has always shown itself to be very flexible and amends the airspace requirements every year. General aviation interest groups are also present at the "Airspace User Talks".

Meaning: VFR (visual flight rules) interests are represented, but the associations also need support, since the experience of these pilots must be included in the discussions. This is where everyone can make suggestions for improvement and bring the necessary influence from practical experience.



What helps the pilot to fly safely? No one intentionally and consciously violates airspace, the problem is more likely to arise from ignorance of the situation. Even VFR (visual flight

Information Circular (AIC) highlights new procedures and rules.


Whether and how the preferred navigation app accepts such changes during regular downloads, must be checked in each case.

The layout of the ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation) chart has been designed so that all factors relevant to VFR (visual flight rules) flying are clear and easily recognisable. For example, representations of the approach base lines in conjunction with altitude information at critical points warn of increased traffic.

Deutsche Flugsicherung (German Air Traffic Control) is the official VFR (visual flight rules) route map for Germany. It contains all important topography and air traffic control information on 8 chart sheets. DFS (German Air Traffic Control) guarantees the content of the chart.

All chart sheets are available as motorised and gliding variants as well as with low-level night flight routes.

The effective date in 2023 is 23 MAR 2023.

The ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation) wall chart, which covers the whole of Germany, is suitable for club and training rooms.

How does au ICAO chart work?

The ICAO chart 1:500,000 accompanies you throughout your pilot life. It is an integral part of classic flight navigation and an absolute must-have during training. The chart gives you a lot of information and there are many symbols than catch the eye.

Glider site

When depicting the glider airfields, a distinction is made between areas with aircraft and winch towing and those that only operate with winch towing. Glider sites are shown on all variants of the ICAO chart. For gliders, however, they are highlighted in yellow for better identification.

Final approaches of instrument flight rules traffic

At controlled aerodromes where no class Č or D airspace is set up, the IFR final approaches are particularly sensitive with regard to an IFR/VFR mixing problem. In order to raise awareness of the IFR (instrument flight rules) final approach areas for the VFR (visual flight rules) pilots, the ICAO chart shows 1:500,000 IFR final approaches including the respective flight altitude at the start of the final approach (marked in red by a cross) at selected IFR aerodromes.






Maximum Elevation Figure

The term can be translated as "greatest height value". The highest scenic elevation and the highest obstacle are compared and the higher value is presented.

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Airfield representation

When airfields are displayed, the most important points for landing preparation are shown. This means that unscheduled stopovers can also be mastered.



Representation of obstacles

The ICAO chart shows obstacles with a height of 100 m (328 ft) above ground and more. The altitude information refers by default to MSL, i.e., mean sea level. If the heights are shown in brackets, they refer to the heights above ground.



Spot elevations are drawn in black with the height above sea level.

Obstacles are man-made, e.g., television towers or wind turbines. The altitude refers to the highest point above sea level and is drawn in blue.

The highest point of the chart is marked on each of the eight chart sheets. This is shown framed. It can be a natural terrain point or a built obstacle.

Built-up areas are only shown on the ICAO map if they have over 5,000 inhabitants. The more inhabitants, the larger the place names are printed.





Incidentally, it is worth turning the ICAO map over: There is helpful information on the back of the ICAO chart.

Among other things, there is a **coordinate ruler:** If the chart is face up, the edge can be folded over. Then you can use the degrees to read the northern latitude of a specific point.

What is the difference between the charts for gliding and what about the low-level night flight routes?

- ★ Altitudes are in metres, not feet.
- ★ Gliding sectors are highlighted in yellow.
- ★ The maximum elevation figure is not shown.
- ★ Airfields with gliding operations are marked in yellow.

Night low flight: Night low flight routes marked in red are shown on the chart. Military low-level flights take place there at night. They are to be regarded as a restricted flight area. The status (active/not active) can be obtained via radio.

The pitot tube protection must be chosen appropriately, since the size of the pitot tube varies depending on the aircraft model. The pitot tube protection can be supplemented with a Remove before flight banner.

- Pilot licence(s) and rating(s)

- ICAO language skills
- Background check (ZÜP)

- Instruction/retraining confirmation
- Comply with legal requirements when taking passengers, towing flights, night flights, etc. (see 90-day rule)
- Comply with internal club requirements
- Flight instructors, examiners and those authorised to instruct:
 - · Proof of flight instructor training

Is the personal equipment complete and functional? This includes:

- Pilot accessories: Knee board, bag, sunglass-
- Technology: Headset, spare batteries, stopwatch, flashlight etc.
- With the appropriate edition: Spare glasses
- Current apps and software
- Current charts
- Flight log
- Equipment for special flight projects, e.g. life jackets, PLB
- Safety vest
- Oxygen system
- Sun protection (hat, sunscreen)
- Appropriate cleaning cloth

③ Knowledge of the pilot

Repetition and refreshing of knowledge is important, especially after a longer flight break. This includes:

- Training for the use of (new) software and apps and their updates
- Assess physical fitness realistically and test it yourself - including eyesight
- Assessment of whether the first flights should take place with a flight instructor (observe the requirements of the club or charter company)
- Check whether there have been any changes in aviation law


